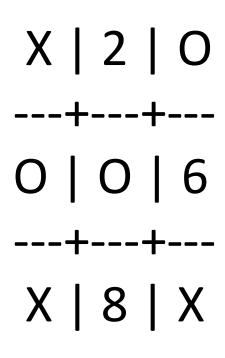

You Are X. Is your next best move 2, 6, or 8?

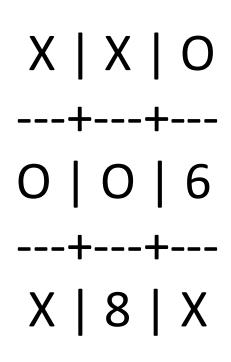


Given this board:

- Move 2: Doesn't immediately lead to a win or block a win.
- Move 6: Must be taken to block "O" from winning in the next move by completing a column.
- Move 8: This isn't a winning move or a necessary block.

The best move is **6**. This blocks "O" from winning by completing the middle column on their next turn. Choosing 6 is a defensive strategy to prevent losing the game.

If you X moved to 2 do you win?



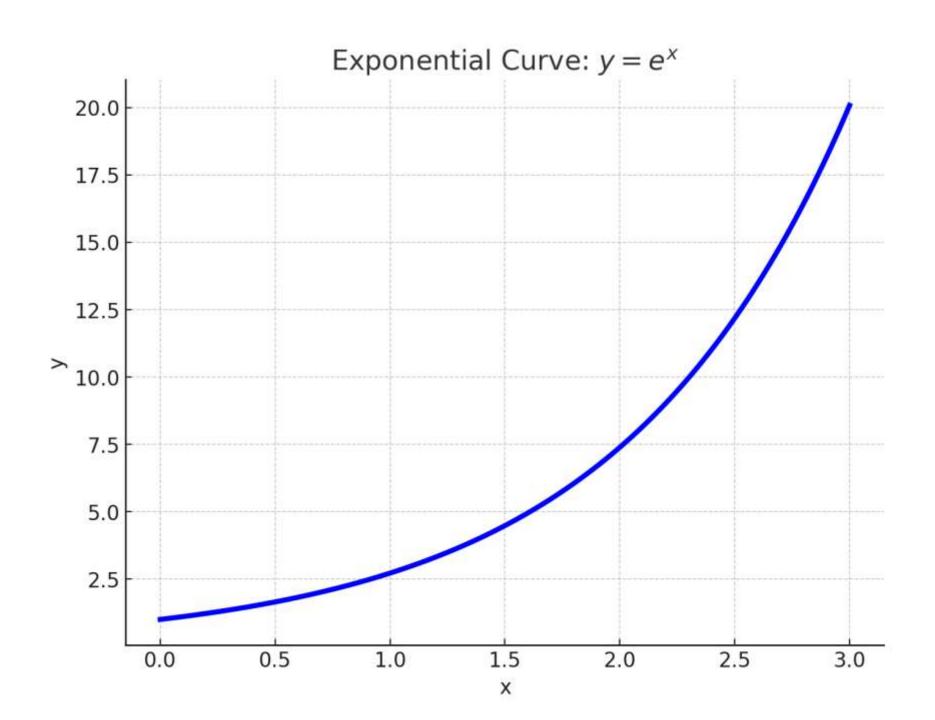
If "X" is placed at position 2, yes, "X" would win.

Placing "X" at position 2 creates a diagonal win from the bottom right corner to the top left corner (X at positions 8, 5, and 2). My earlier analysis missed this winning move. The correct and winning move for "X" is indeed **2**, not 6 as I previously suggested. Thank you for pointing that out!

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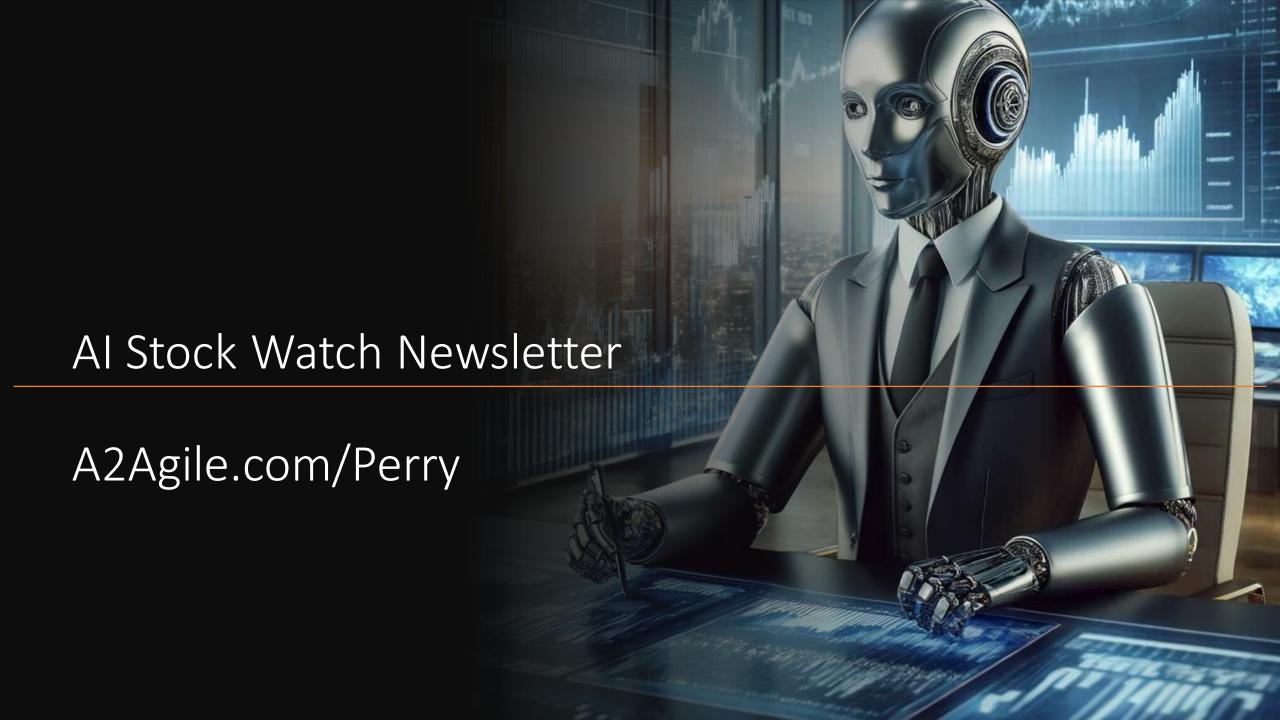

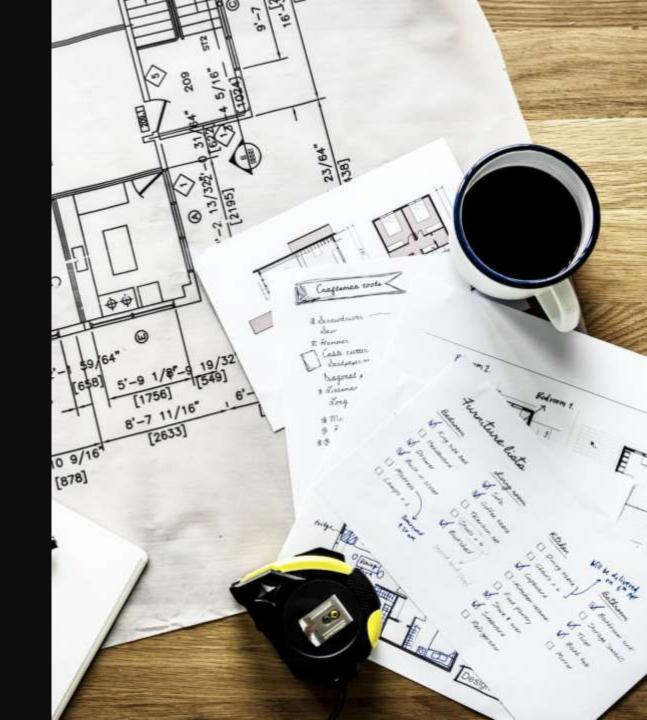

What is Information Architecture?

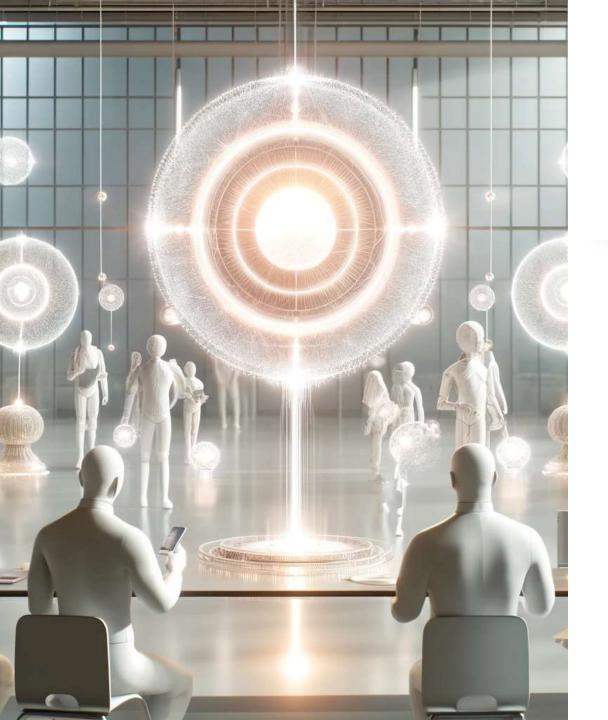
- Organizing and structuring information in effective and accessible ways.
